Semi-Annual General Meeting Highlights

The Semi-Annual General Meeting was held on September 16, 2007 and there were a few things we would like remind you of that were discussed.

The new incentive for the 2007/2008 season will be that the Top 8 men and women will receive a monetary prize. Each side will have \$750 divided amongst the top 8. The breakdown is as follows:

1st: \$200 2nd: \$150 3rd: \$100 4th: \$85 5th: \$70 6th: \$60 7th: \$50 8th: \$35. Any ties will result in a split of the prize money.

All knock-out rounds in MDAI ranked tournaments will now have a best of three games in the best of five sets format. The first best of three games will be the first set. The second best of three games will be the second set, and so on.

Smoke breaks will now occur every two games in the round robins.

Once a player is called to play he/she will be given a three minute warning to start play. If the player does not show up after three minutes to play he/she will be disqualified from playing in all events at that tournament.

Players who cannot participate in zone qualifiers for whatever reason will now have the opportunity to buy into the Provincials for \$100.00 per person. MDAI memberships will now have to be paid by no later than February 8, 2008 if a player wants to qualify to play in the Provincials.

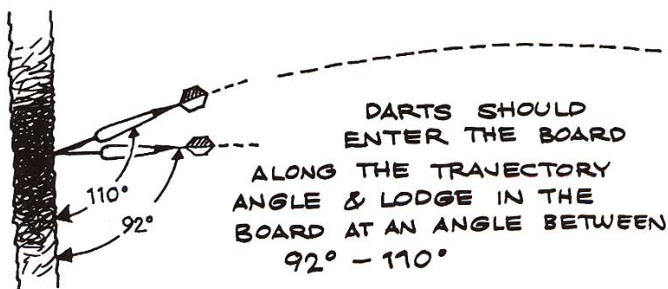
The NDFC Nationals are coming up in only 8 months and the Youth Nationals even sooner – 7 months. We need member support to make these events a success.

I would like to wish everyone good luck and good darts this year. I look forward to seeing you at our Tournaments and at the Provincials.

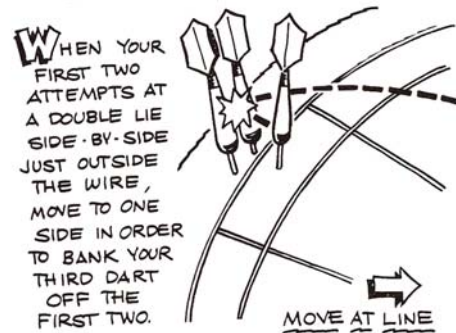

Practice, Practice, Practice

29!

To get good at the game of darts practice is critical. Everyone has different practice regimes but there are many proven techniques that will help you to improve your game. One of them is the game of "29". Many professional dart players use this practice method with great results. Its primary purpose is to improve your accuracy on your doubles and/or triples.

- Start your game by giving yourself 29 points.
- Then throw at the numbers in sequence, 1-20 and then the bull. However you should only target the doubles.
- You will only throw three darts at each of the numbers as they're played. (Three darts at double one, then three darts at double two, then three darts at double three, etc...)
- Keeping score: For each double of the target number you hit, add the actual value of the double to your score. (If your target is double eight and you hit one double eight on that turn, 16 points will be added to your score.) If you fail to hit at least one double of the target number on that turn, you must deduct the single value of the targeted number from your score. (If the target number is fourteen and you fail to hit at least one double, you must deduct 14 points from your current score.)
- If you score multiple hits on the target double on any particular turn you may score all of them accordingly. (If the target number is fifteen and you hits two doubles on that turn, you may add both, or a total of 60 points)
- Maintain a running total on your score throughout the entire round – even if you end up with negative numbers (which is likely to happen more often than you think.) Then simply record your final score and use it as your benchmark to beat on the next round of play.

This practice routine can also easily be modified for triples practice. Simple start with 39 points instead of 29 and make the triples your targets.

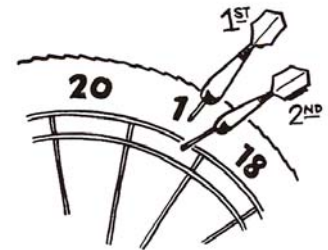
