Manitoba Darts Association Inc. Ranked Tournament Package

Failure to adhere to any items outlined above will result in the tournament being placed on probation for one year.

This guide will outline and allow for consistency amongst all Manitoba Darts Association Inc. (MDAI)'s tournaments.

General

- This guide regulates all ranked tournaments held under the MDAI ranking program
- All ranked tournaments in Manitoba must follow the NDFC Rules of Play
- All tournaments require an MDAI ranking first in order to apply for and receive an NDFC ranking

Fees

- New tournament application fee: \$50.00
- Renewal tournament application fee: \$25.00
- Singles Fee: \$1.00/participant in men's and women's singles events

Tournament Application

- All applications must be submitted to MDAI via [this google form](#)
- All new tournament applications will be brought to the MDAI Board of Directors, with the Ranking Officer's recommendations, for review and approval
 - o Applications for new tournaments must be submitted 90 days prior to the event
- All renewal tournament applications will be reviewed and approved by the Ranking Officer
 - o Applications for tournament renewals must be submitted 90 days prior to the event

Tournament Requirements

- Ranking events for the tournament must include both men's and women's singles events
- Format will be modified round robin, games will be 501, straight in, double out – all events
 - o Singles must be either all 3 games or best of 3 games
 - o Singles knockout will be minimum best of 5, finals minimum best of 7
- Each men's and women's singles events will be seeded by the governing body of the highest ranking first then down through to the subsequent ranking bodies (WDF-NDFC-MDAI)
- Each tournament must be open to all adult and youth players eligible to compete
- Players that are suspended by MDAI or the NDFC are not eligible to compete in any event in any MDAI ranked tournament. [Suspended player lists will be provided to the tournament director]

Tournament Results

- A Google Account will be required in order utilize the form for submitting your tournament summary
- A tournament summary, though [this google form](#), will be required within 48 hours of the completion of the event, including pictures of all events top 4 finishing individuals/teams
 - o Each event has a section on the form for submitting photos of the top 4 participants along with an additional photo spot for the Knockout sheet for the corresponding event
 - o A late penalty will be assessed if paperwork/photos are not received within 48 hours
- Singles fees are due within 7 days of the completion of the event, e-transfer preferred (mbdarts@shaw.ca)
 - o A late penalty will be assessed if fees are not received within 7 days

Tournament Dates

- No MDAI provincially ranked tournaments will be approved on any dates that conflict with existing, historically run MDAI tournaments (this includes the weekend directly before or directly after such tournaments)
- No MDAI provincially ranked tournaments will be approved on any dates that conflict with existing or historically run NDFC ranked tournaments in neighbouring provinces (Saskatchewan, Northern Ontario)

Ranking Schedule

- The ranking period will be May 1 to April 30, with no reset at the start of the ranking year. Results will be calculated year over year.
- Memberships must be purchased by the cut-off date set by the NDFC in order to points to count, points will be calculated to this date and will be removed if membership is not in good standing at that time
