If you are unable to play in your Qualifiers, you can buy your way into the Provincials if you are the Top 8 on the MDAI Ranking List or if you played on Team Manitoba National Team the previous year for \$150. The deadline for buying your way into the Provincials will be February 28<sup>th</sup>.

You can only play in one Zone qualifiers to qualify to play in the provincials.

The number of players going to Provincials for each zone will be based on number of players participating at their qualifiers. There are 24 spots for women and 48 spots for men available between Zone 1, 2 & 3 to participate at the Provincials.
